



About e-Filing



e-Filing system is a complete end to end solution developed for online filing of complaints, written statements, replies and various applications related to cases. Both Civil and Criminal cases can be filed before any High Court or District Court of the country. It is designed in Bilingual (English and local language) to reach wider group covering advocates/litigants.

- Positive impact on environment by reducing paper footprint




Features of e-Filing

- Online Submission of Vakalat** Online creation and submission of Vakalat
- e-Signing** Signing of uploaded document by multiple parties
- Online Payment** Online payment of court fee
- Online Video Recording of Oath** Administer the oath by online video recording
- Application Filing** Filing of several applications for different cases simultaneously
- Portfolio Management** Portfolio and planner for managing cases
- My Partners** Add colleagues, juniors etc as partners
- Dashboard** Status of all the completed/pending case related activities

Why ICJS was needed

Earlier:


- Police had FIR data
 - Courts had case data
 - Prisons had inmate data
- ➔ All were working in **separate silos**

Problems:

- Delay in case progress
- Repeated data entry
- Manual communication
- Lack of real-time status

ICJS solves this by integrating systems.

Agencies Integrated under ICJS

ICJS connects **five major pillars** of the Criminal Justice System:

1. Police – CCTNS

- Crime and Criminal Tracking Network & Systems
- FIRs, arrests, charge sheets

Prosecution

- Case scrutiny
- Legal opinions
- Trial monitoring

Courts – eCourts

- Case registration

Prisons – ePrisons

- Prisoner admission & release
- Parole, furlough
- Sentence calculation

Forensics – NAFIS / FSL systems

- Fingerprints
- DNA
- Forensic reports

i-Court Fees



i-Court Fees is an **online system for payment of court fees** through electronic mode instead of traditional physical court fee stamps.

It is part of the **eCourts Project** and supports **e-Filing and digital case management**.

Why i-Court Fees was introduced

Earlier system:


- Physical court fee stamps
- Manual verification
- Risk of fake / reused stamps
- Delay in scrutiny

i-Court Fees solves these issues by enabling:

- Online payment
- Auto-verification
- Transparent accounting
