AIMS AND OBJECTIVES OF JUDICIAL ACADEMY, JHARKHAND

The Judicial Academy, Jharkhand was established on 4th January 2002 at Ranchi pursuant to the directions of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in *All India Judges' Association v. Union of India*, (2002) 4 SCC 247. The Academy initially functioned from the premises of the Shri Krishna Institute of Public Administration (SKIPA) on Meur's Road, Ranchi. With the objective of providing a dedicated and modern training environment, the Academy shifted on 10th October 2015 to its permanent, purpose-built campus at Dhurwa, Ranchi, equipped with state-of-the-art academic and training facilities.

In accordance with Clause 3 of the Judicial Academy, Jharkhand Regulations, 2002, the Academy is mandated to impart structured and continuing training to Judicial Officers, newly appointed members of the Jharkhand Judicial Service, officers and members of the High Court Registry, and ministerial staffs. The Academy seeks to strengthen institutional capacity through systematic, skill-oriented programmes designed to enhance adjudicatory competence, promote procedural efficiency, minimise delays, and improve overall standards in the administration of justice.

Beyond the enhancement of legal knowledge and technical competence, the Academy is committed to cultivating high standards of judicial ethics, institutional accountability, and transparency in the discharge of judicial functions. It promotes sensitivity towards the rights and concerns of marginalized and vulnerable sections of society and provides a structured forum for constructive engagement among the Bar, Bench, Legislature, and Executive. The training methodology incorporates interactive sessions, panel deliberations, workshops, and practice-oriented discussions to ensure meaningful and participatory learning.

To further strengthen the quality of judicial training, the Academy has institutionalised the circulation of significant judgments for structured in-house discussion. This initiative enables Judicial Officers to critically analyse and collectively examine important rulings, thereby promoting consistency in adjudication and a deeper understanding of evolving legal principles and contemporary jurisprudence.

To enhance the effectiveness and relevance of its training programmes, the Academy has adopted a system of collecting queries in advance, enabling focused deliberation on practical challenges encountered by Judicial Officers. These

issues are addressed comprehensively by resource persons and faculty members during the sessions. Furthermore, structured district-level discussions have been instituted to facilitate direct interaction among Judicial Officers and other stakeholders. These forums encourage collaborative problem-solving, exchange of best practices, and the sharing of practical insights, thereby strengthening uniformity and efficiency in judicial functioning.

The Judicial Academy regularly publishes comprehensive study materials addressing significant and contemporary legal issues relevant to judicial functioning. These publications are designed to provide practical guidance and structured solutions to challenges encountered in day-to-day court proceedings, thereby enhancing the quality, consistency, and efficiency of judicial decision-making. In furtherance of sustained academic engagement, the Academy publishes a trimonthly newsletter documenting academic programmes, expert contributions, and significant developments in jurisprudence. Additionally, monthly case snippets highlighting recent and important judgments of the Hon'ble Supreme Court are published to facilitate continuous judicial update and doctrinal clarity.

To ensure wider dissemination and accessibility, these materials are made available through the Academy's official website: <https://jajharkhand.in>, enabling Judicial Officers

across the State to access curated academic resources and reference materials. This initiative promotes continuous professional development and institutional uniformity in judicial practice. The Academy also encourages Judicial Officers to contribute scholarly articles and research papers, thereby fostering a culture of legal writing, critical analysis, and meaningful engagement with evolving legal principles.

The Judicial Academy, Jharkhand conducts Regional and State-level Conferences, Symposia, and Specialised Training Programmes on contemporary legal issues and recent developments in legislation and judicial pronouncements. These programmes encompass, inter alia, cyber laws and electronic evidence, data protection, IPR, Environmental Laws, medical forensics, juvenile justice, adjudication of motor accident claim cases, matrimonial disputes, human trafficking and human rights matters, as well as NDPS and POCSO cases, with the objective of keeping stakeholders informed of evolving legal paradigms. A key institutional focus remains the integration of modern technology into judicial practice, ensuring that Judicial Officers are proficient in case management, court administration, and the effective utilisation of digital platforms such as the National Judicial Data Grid (NJDG) and the Court Information System (CIS).

Recognising the importance of professional well-being, the Academy also conducts programmes on stress

management, yoga, and wellness to enhance judicial efficiency. It further promotes constructive Bar-Bench engagement through seminars and research-oriented initiatives. Committed to excellence in judicial education, the Judicial Academy, Jharkhand strives to strengthen professional competence, ethical standards, and legal knowledge, thereby contributing to an effective, transparent, and accountable justice delivery system.

The Judicial Academy, Jharkhand has successfully completed its training programmes for the Academic Year 2025–26. As it enters the Academic Year 2026–27, the Academy reaffirms its commitment to providing comprehensive and structured training to Judicial Officers and all stakeholders associated with the justice delivery system.

During the Academic Year 2026–27, the Academy endeavours to further advance legal education and professional development through a series of carefully conceived and systematically implemented initiatives. As part of this academic framework, the Academy will continue to publish a Trimonthly Newsletter documenting its workshops, training programmes, and scholarly deliberations, while duly recognising the valuable contributions of resource persons in their respective domains. Additionally, Monthly Case Snippets highlighting recent and significant judgments of the

Hon'ble Supreme Court will be issued to ensure continuous judicial engagement with evolving jurisprudential developments.

The Academy will also be facilitating in-house discussions on recent judicial pronouncements at district headquarters to promote sustained knowledge-sharing and ensure uniformity in judicial standards and capacity building. To enhance technological competence, online computer skill enhancement programmes will be conducted for District Judges. Further, intra-Jharkhand regional training programmes at the district level will be organised to strengthen decentralised capacity building, skill development, and professional excellence among Judicial Officers. As part of its institutional initiatives, the Judicial Academy, Jharkhand will conduct structured Training-of-Trainers (TOT) programmes for Advocates, Advocate's Clerks, and Ministerial Staff to strengthen institutional capacity, ensure effective dissemination of e-Courts initiatives, and promote uniform implementation of digital judicial processes across the State.

Through these structured initiatives, the Academy remains steadfast in its endeavour to advance judicial knowledge, institutional efficiency, and professional standards during the Academic Year 2026–27.
